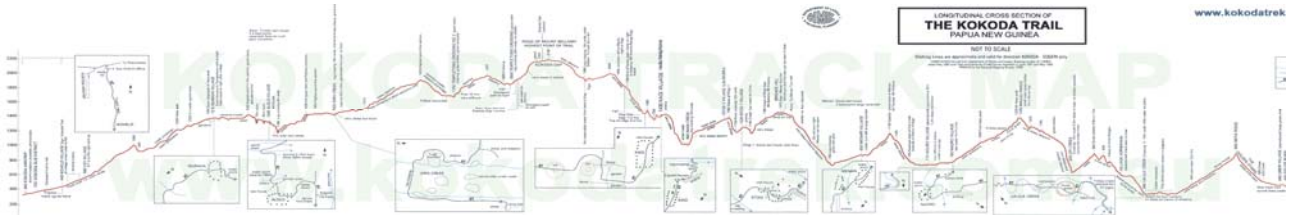




Kokoda Challenge 2012



Have you ever wanted to do something extra-ordinary, something that takes you out of your everyday experience, challenges your perceived limits and puts life into perspective? Walking the Kokoda Trail is a life-changing experience and a unique opportunity to not only honour the sacrifices of those young Australians who fought for our freedom in 1942 but also to give back to the communities who supported us along the track and to raise funds to support individuals, families and carers impacted by cancer here in Western Australia.

BALYA Cancer Self Help & Wellness Inc is a non profit organisation which offers a full range of services, information and support to people with a diagnosis of cancer, their families, supporters and carers; enabling them to make informed decisions about their condition and treatment. Balya also educates health professionals and the broader community about cancer, its prevention and treatment. It is the only organisation in WA providing this range of services, to people who've been diagnosed with cancer, and to their families.

In 2012, supporters of Balya will be walking the Kokoda Trail to raise funds for the Balya Cancer Retreat Appeal. Balya Wellness Retreats provide "time-out" from everyday routines and stresses, and in a relaxed, peaceful setting, for patients and their carers to consider how to deal with cancer in a holistic way. Funds raised from the Balya Kokoda Challenge will contribute to the expansion of Balya Cancer Retreat Complex.
